SacEV ECO-Challenge #4

FREE --- PRIZES --- FUN --- LIVE COVERSATION --- CHALLENGE Saturday, March 6

A gathering for EVs and drivers of any EV to test eco-driving skills and the ultimate economy of operation of their vehicle. Winner will be the car/driver with the lowest watts/mile for an ~31 mile course.

We have been missing our EV group "energy" for way too long and this is a "social distancing" appropriate chance for us to be in proximity with our kindred environmental supporters and to test our cars and our skills at getting the most efficient driving outcomes our vehicles can demonstrate. Masks to be worn for outside stand-around time.

All types of BEVs are welcome! Nissan Leaf, E-Golf, 500e, Tesla, etc. There are >10 different EV charging points within 400m of our meeting point at the McDonald's on Ikea Ct. in West Sacramento. This is a Free EVent and there are gift certificate prizes, all supported by SacEV.

Meet **no later than 8:30 am** at the McDonald's at the entry to IKEA Ct., West Sacramento. Reset your trip odometer when you park at McDonald's. Cars will be staged at 2 minute intervals beginning 9:00 am for departure from McDonald's to:

- Drive to Woodland along "Old River Road" (~15 miles). Use hwy 102 overpass returning on I-5 freeway to the exit (!4.5 miles) back to Old River Road, returing to McDonald's. Each driver takes a photo of the power operating display showing watts/mile or similar info that can be translated to watts/mile.
- This ECO-LOOP is approximately 31 miles and must be completed within 44 minutes of departure. Drivers must average 45-50 mph. Drivers MUST maintain actual "freeway speed" for ~5 miles entering I-5 In Woodland to the exit to Old River Road.
- Join others afterwards for scoring/ranking and bragging.
- Charging is available in IKEA Ct. area, both Level 2 and DC fast charging!
- AWARDS: Gift Card(s)
- Competition categories: 1. Large EVs, over 5000 pounds GVW, Medium EVs,, 4000 to 5000 pounds (Model 3, Model Y, etc.), and smaller EVs, Fiat, VW, Kia, Hyundai, etc.

Date: Saturday, March 6 **Time:** No later than 8:30 am

Where: McDonald's at entry to IKEA Ct. West Sacramento. Reset trip odometer before challenge!
