who provided their personal views on the importance of Climate Action. The large number of citizens desiring to comment caused the standard two minute time slots per speaker to be reduced to one minute. Everyone still managed to deliver important messages to the commission. The next time you see these people, tell them thanks for stepping up.

Our next step is working with the rest of the Technical Advisory Committee to specifically define what the 80% EV goal means. If you'd like to help out, let me know.

#### **Transit & Shared Mobility**

Expand and improve transit and shared mobility services to be more competitive with single occupancy vehicle use so that by 2030, 30% of all trips are by transit and pooled shared mobility, 50% by 2045.

#### **Active Transportation**

Expand and enhance accessibility to low-stress connected infrastructure for walking and rolling so that by 2030, 30% of all trips are by active transportation, 40% by 2045.

### **Vehicle Electrification**

Electrify 80% of the transportation sector including all personal and shared vehicles, public fleets, and private fleets, by 2030, 100% by 2045.
