## **SMUD Plans 344 Megawatt Solar Farm**



SMUD is planning to build and operate the Country Acres Solar Project, a 344-megawatt photovoltaic solar power and battery storage facility. Project plans include a generation substation, a switch station, and interconnection lines to SMUD's grid. Country Acres will provide a new renewable power resource that supports SMUD's 2030 Zero Carbon Plan to eliminate carbon emissions from

its current gas-fired power plants.
