### A Critical Time For You to be Heard



Next weeks, California's Air Resources Board will hear a proposal to require all new cars be zero emission by 2035. Since passenger vehicles are the state's single largest source of global warming emissions, this rule is a huge deal for the climate.

We are already seeing the impacts of climate change, from deadly wildfires to crippling drought, and the science indicates that we are simply not reducing emissions fast enough. 2035 is too late. Given how long new cars stay on the road, requiring more ZEV sales in the near term will lock in fewer tailpipe emissions for the decades ahead.
