CalSEED \$4.2 million Grants to Clean Energy Innovations

Oakland, CA, 14 October 2020 – The California Sustainable Energy Entrepreneur Development program is pleased to announce that the fourth cohort of innovative clean energy concepts has been approved by the California Energy

Commission. 28 companies out of 212 were selected to receive grants of \$150,000 each to become our new Concept Awardees.

CalSEED is an initiative made possible by the California Energy Commission. The CalSEED initiative will provide \$24 million in grants over five years to support innovators working on early-stage clean energy concepts. CalSEED is administered by New Energy Nexus.



Governmental Solar Power Challenge

With wildfires in California, elections nearing, high electric bills and the 26% Solar Tax Credit expiring, both Biden (2020) and Clinton (2015) have

called for 500 million solar panels, yet few politicians' homes have solar. Challenge our politicians to take personal and professional action now, before more natural disasters occur so we all do our part to help the whole country.

The White House had solar in 1979, thanks to Jimmy Carter. Reagan pulled them down. Bush put some solar back up. Obama put on more solar.

The Ohio Governor's Mansion was the first in the nation. At the 2003 Ohio State Fair, First Lady Hope Taft (wife of Republican Governor Bob Taft) brought the idea of a photovoltaic or solar electric system at the Ohio Governor's Residence to Green Energy Ohio. The project was completed in 2004 and dedicated on October 15, the day before the 2nd Annual Ohio Solar Tour.

Volvo Trucks NA awarded California EV grants

Volvo Trucks North America was awarded \$21.7 million in grants to deploy 70 VNR Electric trucks in Southern California for regional freight distribution and drayage. Deliveries are to begin 2021 through Q3 2022, with the order expected to be completed by the third quarter of 2022.
